They launched in 2017 to address three unique challenges with one program:

1. to meet the academic, physical, social-emotional, and spiritual needs of children from low income communities
2. to provide meaningful options for college age young adults to explore ministry opportunities and develop as young principled leaders for the church and the world
3. to help revitalize churches in underserved communities.
